
Vote Hemp[™] States Report

- 29 states introduced hemp legislation
- 4 *NEW* hemp states
- 31 states with hemp laws
- 17.2 k constituent actions





The map below represents advocates in each state that made calls or sent letters to Congress in support of the Industrial Hemp Farming Act. Between January and December 2016 nearly 4k advocates took action 17.2k times. In 2015, a little more than 10,000 actions were recorded by Vote Hemp's advocacy database. Vote Hemp met it's 2016 goal to record 15k actions of support for S. 134 and H.R. 525 before the end of the year.




